



1 HAHOE VILLAGE AREA



Hahoe Village
UNESCO World Heritage

This is a clan village of the family, Pungsan Ryu(柳氏), and obtained Hahoe since Nakdong River flows around the village. It is the most appropriate place to understand traditional culture as the buildings from the early Joseon Dynasty and the folk culture of Hahoe Byeolsingut Talnori and Seonyu Jubulnori remain intact. UNESCO registered Hahoe village, which has outstanding universal value as a cultural heritage of humanity, as a World Heritage Site in 2010.

Byeongsan Seowon
UNESCO World Heritage

Byeongsan Seowon, built by Seae Ryu Seong-ryong in 1572 (the 5th year of King Seonjo's reign), arranged its buildings to actively embrace the outstanding river and mountains surrounding it. Among these buildings, Mandaeu is the height embracing nature and demonstrates the excellence of architectural thinking. Byeongsan Seowon was highly regarded for its architectural beauty and outstanding universal value and was registered as a World Heritage Site in 2019.



Wolyeongs Bridge

Wolyeong Bridge, the largest wooden bridge in Korea, has beautiful illumination at night. Fountains installed on both sides of the bridge spurt cool streams of water. They say that if you take a picture at the octagonal pavilion located in the center of Wolyeong Bridge and make a wish on a Moon boat under Wolyeong Bridge, your wish will come true.

Bongjeonsa Temple
UNESCO World Heritage

This temple has Gaungnyeok, the oldest wooden building in Korea, as well as Daewongjeon, Hwaom Auditorium, and Gyeongmudang built during the Joseon Dynasty, being a valuable resource for architectural research. There are also buildings such as the three-story stone pagoda, Manseru, and Yosachae built during the Goryeo Dynasty, as well as attached hermitages such as Yeongsanram and Jijam. In June 2018, the 42nd World Heritage Committee registered seven temples, including Bongjeonsa Temple as UNESCO World Heritage Sites as Mountain Temples, and Mountain Monasteries of Korea.




Icheon-dong Ma-ae-yeorae Ipsang

This standing statue is called 'Jeobwon Mireuk, a rock-carved Buddha from the Goryeo Dynasty with a 10m high body carved into a granite stone wall and a 2.5m high head laid on the body.

Dosan Seowon
UNESCO World Heritage/Historic Site No. 170

Dosan Seowon is a school built by Toegye Lee Hwang, the greatest Confucian scholar in Korea, known as the Haedong Confucian scholar, to build Dosan Seodang and educate students after he passed away and commemorate the teacher's high virtue by his disciples and Confucian scholars.



Andong Gunja Village

This village is a historic site where the buildings designated as cultural assets and other old houses, which have been inhabited by the clan of Gyeongsan Kim family for 600 years for over 20 generations, were relocated to avoid being submerged due to the construction of Andong Dam in 1974.

Gosanjeong Pavilion
Tangible Cultural Property No. 274

Gosanjeong is located below Gasonghyeop, one of the eight scenic views of Andong. It is surrounded by external and internal mountains like a folding screen, and across Gasonghyeop, the upper stream of the Nakdong River, Doksan Mountain rises along with pine trees, creating a spectacular view.

You can access "Korean Confucian Bookplate," a UNESCO Memory of the World heritage site, and "Korean Framed Pictures," through an open storage room.

Toegye Jongtaek
Gyeongseongbuk-do Monument No. 42

In 1929, the 13th generation of Toegye Lee Hwang restored Toegye's Head Residence to its original size. It is a "ㄱ" shaped building with 6 rooms on the front and 5 rooms on the side, and has a tall gate on the front.

Mukgye Seowon

This is a seowon that honors Bobaekdang Kim Gye-haeng and Eunggye Okgo, scholars in the Joseon Dynasty. It is also a place with a painful history, having been founded during the reign of King Sukjong of the Joseon Dynasty, and restored after being demolished due to Heungseon Daewongun's order to demolish the Seowon.



Manhyujeong Pavilion

This building is a pavilion built in 500 years ago by Bobaekdang Kim Gye-haeng, a civil servant in the early Joseon Dynasty, after he returned to his hometown. This pavilion consists of 3 rooms on the front and 2 rooms on the side. The front side was opened in an upper floor type to allow viewing of the natural scenery, and ondol rooms were placed on both sides to be used as study spaces.

Yonggye Ginkgo Tree

This tree is estimated to be about 700 years old and is a huge tree reaching 37m in height. According to the legend, Tak Sun-chang, who served as a training commander during the reign of King Seonjo of the Joseon Dynasty, returned to his hometown after the Japanese invasions of Korea and organized a group to protect this tree and enjoy chatting under its shade.

Andongpo

Andongpo, considered the best fabric due to the influence of climate and soil, is a thin, yellow hemp fabric that was presented to the palace in the past. Andongpo is produced in Gaumsun, Imha-myeon, and was designated as the first intangible cultural asset of Gyeongseongbuk-do.

Andong Hanji

Andong's Poongsan Hanji, which boasts world-class materials, is made using traditional processing methods using domestic natural mulberry trees, has excellent absorbency and dispersion properties, and is used for window paper, wallpaper, rice paper, and crafts.

Hahoe Mask

This is a mask made by carving alder trees, covered with Hanji, painted and then lacquered. It was used in Byeolsingut and 11 Hanjis of 10 types are handed down.

Andong Soju

Andong Soju is a grain alcohol brewed three times from rice, and is characterized by the distillation method that has been passed down from famous families in the Andong region, and was designated as Gyeongseongbuk-do's Intangible Cultural Heritage No. 12.

Andong Salted Mackerel

Andong Salted Mackerel is originated where seafood from Yeongdeok was brought to Andong for sale, and is made by salting fresh mackerel caught in the southeastern coastal waters.

Andong Heotjesatbap

This bibimbap is made using the same ingredients of the ancestral rice food, following the Andong custom of eating bibimbap as ancestral rice food after an ancestral rite.

Andong Jjimdak

This is a food that combines vegetables such as potatoes, spinach, and green onions with chicken and glass noodles to create a harmonious combination of spicy, sweet, and light taste.

Andong Korean Beef

Andong Korean cow, raised through a unique breeding method in a clear and clean natural environment, provides high-quality beef with a unique taste and aroma due to even distribution of fat in the meat.

Andong Sikhye

This is a traditional drink made by mixing hard-boiled rice with radish, red pepper powder, ginger juice, malt, and water and fermented to create a cool, spicy, and sweet taste. This can only be tasted in Andong.

Chrysanthemum Tea

Andong's chrysanthemum, which is carefully cultivated in clean Andong and the tea undergo rigorous processing procedures, is a high-quality health tea that preserves the unique taste, color, and deep aroma of chrysanthemums.

264 Green Grape Wine

This wine has a rich fruity flavor and refreshing acidity, so it goes well with Korean food, and is receiving good reviews as it undergoes winemaking, maturation techniques, and quality testing.

Andong Ginger Extract

Andong ginger is grown with the energy of the fertile land of Andong, and is manufactured by inheriting the taste of Andong noble families. This product boasts the highest quality because it is processed using 100% raw ginger.
