Hahoe, partly encircled by the Nakdong River, was so named because of its geographical location Ha means "water", and Hoe means "circle". It is considered one of the best folk villages in Korea, and it has preserved a number of cultural traditions that echo the lives of both noblemen and commoners, including a traditional Korean maskdance and traditional Korean fireworks. It has also served as the home for the descendants of the Pungsan line of Andong's Ryu family for over 600 years.

### Hahoe Maskdane Drama

The Hahoe Maskdance is a satirical performance that tells of the conflict between the upper and lower classes in traditional Korea, and it was performed as a sort of shaman ritual at intervals of three, five, or ten years, when the village was suffering problems or when there was an outbreak of disease. Nowadays, however, the aspects of fun and entertainment are stronger than the ritual.. What makes the maskdance so special is its masks. Where most traditional masks are made of paper or gourd, Hahoe masks are made of alder wood and are wonderfully carved in various expressions.

### Lee Hwang(Toegye)


Lee Hwang (1501~70), known more commonly by his penname, Toegye, was one of Korea's most respected neo-Confucian scholars. Lee ardently studied neo-Confucianism and developed it further based on his theory of gyeong, or mindfulness. He passed the national government test at the age of 34 and served in high position in the central government in the capital. After his service, he returned to his hometown and




# Bongjeongsa Temple

Bongjeongsa Temple is famous for Geuknakjeon Hall, the oldest wooden structure in Korea. Bong means "phoenix", "jeong" means "stay" and sa means "temple". Legend goes, that in 672, the monk Uisang made a paper phoenix, cast it into the air, and then decided to build the temple on the spot where it landed. Bongjeongsa has a three story pagoda that was made in the Goryo Dynasty, Daeungjeon Hall from the early Joseon Dynasty, and Haeomgangdang Hall from the mid-Joseon, all of which give visitors the opportunity to see various styles of Korean architecture.







This book was written by Ryu Seong-ryong(1542~1607), a scholar and high ranking official, during the Japanese invasion of 1592~1598. The book records the event during the war, such as national resistance against the Japanese invaders, rescue of Joseon by the Chinese Ming Dynasty, and the progress of battles of the navy. The title 'Jingbi' means 'precaution saves later troubles'. This is important historical material for he study of the Japanese invasion of 1592-98.

### Sangdeoksa Shrine(Treasure No.211) 상다.

This shrine contains the memorial tablets of Lee Hwang and Mok, one of Lee's disciples. Every February and August, memorial ceremonies are held to honor the mand their teachings.

selected works by Lee Hwang. However, for reasons of preservation, the books were moved to the Korean Studies Advancement Center



In the Joseon Dynasty, most government examinations were held in Seoul, the capital of Korea. But in 1792,King Jeongjo(r.1776-1800)orderd certain exams to be held here at Dosan to commemorize Lee Hwang's achievement. Sisadan was moved from its former location to here

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


